**Gospel Luke 9:5 I -end** A village refuses to accept Jesus, but he rebukes the disciples for suggesting they should call down fire upon it. One would-be follower wants to return home to bury his father, while another wants to say farewell to those at home. Jesus says that no one who looks back is fit for the kingdom of God.
