# **T4U Shoeboxes Update**

"The boxes this year will be going out to Eastern Romania. The first drop will be to Braila on the Danube. The area is very poor as the industry has disappeared, there are no universities and so a lot of the youngsters do not stay around for long. Pastor Ben is our partner and with his wife run a house within an orphanage where he takes care of 10 children, there are 4 houses in the orphanage each with a set of house parents.

We will be distributing to the orphanage and other orphanages in the area belonging to the state as well as poor families. We have been asked if we can also distribute boxes to a disabled children's orphanage of 120 children. Also the boxes are being distributed in villages and towns around this area."
