## **PRAYERS AND READINGS**

### **Collect**

True and humble king, hailed by the crowd as Messiah: grant us the faith to know you and love you, that we may be found beside you on the way of the cross, which is the path of glory. **Amen**

### **Post Communion**

Lord Jesus Christ, you humbled yourself in taking the form of a servant, and in obedience died on the cross for our salvation: give us the mind to follow you and to proclaim you as Lord and King, to the glory of God the Father. **Amen**

## **Readings 14 April Palm Sunday**

**Liturgy of the Palms: Gospel Luke 19:28-40** Having sent the disciples ahead to untie and bring a colt to him, Jesus rides it into Jerusalem, to be greeted by a rapturous crowd.

**Liturgy of the Passion: First Reading Isaiah 50:4-9a** With the Lord on our side we have nothing to fear.

**Second Reading Philippians 2:5-11** Christians are to put aside personal ambition and follow Christ's example of humble servanthood, allowing God to work in them, as Christ was raised to glory.

**Gospel Luke 22:14 – end of 23, or Luke 23:1-49** The passion story takes us through the Last Supper, Peter's cowardly act of denial, the betrayal by Judas Iscariot, Jesus brought before Pilate, his journey through Jerusalem to his place of execution, and his death upon the cross. Through it all, until the final bleak hours of his mission on earth, Jesus displays compassion and grace, courage and obedience.

## **PRAYERS AND READINGS**

**Collect** God of glory, by the raising of your Son you have broken the chains of death and hell: fill your Church with faith and hope; for a new day has dawned and the way to life stands open in our Saviour Jesus Christ. **Amen**

**Post Communion** God of Life, who for our redemption gave your only-begotten Son to the death of the cross, and by his glorious resurrection have delivered us from the power of our enemy: grant us so to die daily to sin, that we may evermore live with him in the joy of his risen life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

### **Today's Readings**

**First Reading Acts 10:34-43** (The reading from Acts must be used as either the first or second reading.) Peter testifies that Jesus' resurrection is not just for the Jewish people. Forgiveness and healing is on offer to all who believe.

**Or Isaiah 65:17-end** The prophet sees a time when sin and death will be no more. Conflict will be a thing of the past, and we will care for the world around us.

**Second Reading I Corinthians 15:19-26** The hope of the risen Christ is not only for this life. All of Christ's enemies, even death, will be defeated, and all those who have died will be made alive.

**Or Acts 10:34-43**

**Gospel John 20:1-18** Mary Magdalene encounters Jesus in the garden. The risen Lord reveals himself to us in our despair.

**Or Luke 24:1-12** We do not serve a dead saviour. Jesus is alive, and will be found among the living.
