Gospel Luke 2:22- 40 Jesus was ritually presented in the Temple as an ordinary human baby, but would offend many by transcending religious practice and reaching out to save all God's children.

Readings: (Year A)

First Reading I Corinthians 2:1-12 [13-end] Paul tells the Corinthians that he did not come to them with lofty words or wisdom, and that God's wisdom is not of this age. God has revealed wisdom through the Spirit and those not taught by the Spirit do not receive spiritual gifts.

Gospel Matthew 5:13-20 In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus tells his followers they are the salt of the earth and the light of the world. Furthermore, he tells them he has not come to abolish the law and the prophets, but to fulfil them. Only those whose righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees will enter the kingdom of heaven.
