## Home for a church organ?

All Saint's church in Shorthampton have a new organ and so are looking for a home for their existing organ.

It is a Wyvern electronic organ, single manual, no pedals, built-in speakers. It has a bunch of buttons to do an automatic pedal effect, split the keyboard between two different sets of sounds, and so on.

It would particularly suit a church with a congregation up to 30 people. Alternatively a church organist may like to have it at home as a practice instrument.

No charge for the organ but the new owner would have to arrange transport.
