Update from Geoffrey:

New Bishop of Dorchester. Last week The Venerable Gavin Collins was announced as the Bishop Designate of Dorchester. Gavin, 53, is presently Archdeacon of The Meon in the Diocese of Portsmouth. Gavin is married to Christina, who is a Health Visitor, and they have 3 young adult children. Gavin will be consecrated on January 28th 2021 and begin his ministry as Bishop of Dorchester in March. As of this Sunday 6th December we are now permitted to hold Church Services with a congregation. Churches in all 3 tiers can now hold services. To this end we will be holding all our planned services including the mid-week Wednesday Communion in Milton. In all of our church buildings we are working hard to maintain regular cleaning to ensure your safety. We still need to wear a face mask or covering in church, and congregational singing is also not permitted. Some people will feel that they must stay at home which is perfectly understandable. We will continue to post a recording of the Sunday service online.

Shipton church update: Lang the building specialists have started work. To begin with they are just doing the preparation work which should take until the beginning of January. Lang's have indicated that they hope to complete the work in March 2021. We hope the church will remain open for this first stage of the work and services will continue as planned.
