National Day of Reflection Tuesday 23 March 2021

On 23 March 2021, it'll be one year since the first UK lockdown. Since then, millions of people have been bereaved, both as a result of Covid-19 and due to other causes. The restrictions we've all been living under have meant that many people have had to grieve without the comfort of having friends and family around them. Marie Curie has organised a National Day of Reflection to acknowledge grief and loss over the last year. The national Church of England is one of several

organisations supporting it.
