PRAYERS AND READINGS (YEAR C)

Collect Heavenly Father, your Son battled with the powers of darkness, and grew closer to you in the desert: help us to use these days to grow in wisdom and prayer that we may witness to your saving love in Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

Post Communion Lord God, you have renewed us with the living bread from heaven; by it you nourish our faith, increase our hope, and strengthen our love: teach us always to hunger for him who is the true and living bread, and enable us to live by every word that proceeds from out of your mouth; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

First Reading Romans 10:8b-13 Quoting from Deuteronomy, Paul says, "The word is near you, on your lips and in your heart." It behoves us to become more familiar with scripture, so it can be a resource in times of trial. The word growing within our memories and hearts deepens our faith.

Gospel Luke 4:1-13 Luke implies that the very purpose of Jesus' time in the wilderness was to be tempted. Clearly Jesus was on his own in this place. The idea of Jesus recounting the episode to his disciples is wholly credible, as he associates Satan with temptation on several other occasions.

Churchyard Butterfly Survey 2022

The Wychwood Forest Trust wishes to work with local churches in a project to identify and record the butterflies in their churchyards. At present, only one of more than twenty churchyards in the area has someone recording butterflies and many more could be recorded with more volunteers. These churchyards could potentially hold colonies of scarce butterflies of which we are currently unaware.

If you would be willing to devote just half an hour a month in May, June, July and August to survey your local churchyard, we would like to hear from you. Identification guides will be available for those involved as well as an initial on-site training visit if required.

This initiative is part of a wider project to increase awareness and appreciation of butterflies across churchyards, gardens, parks and countryside in and around the Wychwood Forest.
